Invitation for Tenders

1. The Tanzania Sugar Board, hereinafter referred to as “the Employer”, intends using part of the proceeds of a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of construction of Msolwa Ujamaa irrigation Scheme in Kilombero I
2. The Employer now invites sealed tenders from eligible contractors registered or capable of being registered in **Class III and above** for carrying out the following works
 - Construction of 2310m in Main supply canal including 5 off take structure and drop falls. Repairing 3 sluice gate valves.
 - Construction of night storage reservoir of capacity 25.1MI.
 - Construction of 685m of secondary canal including 5 offtake boxes and 3 drop falls
 - Excavation of 5700m tertiary canal
 - Reshaping and gravel surfacing of 6.5km farm roads and main drain.

- Land forming and land preparation for 100ha of sugarcane
 - Crop development for 100ha of sugarcane
3. Tendering will be conducted through the National competitive bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the Procurement Regulations, and is open to all Tenderers as defined in the Regulations. Tenderers must also meet additional eligibility requirements as described in the Tendering document.
 4. Interested eligible Tenderers may obtain further information from and inspect the Tendering Documents at the office of the **Secretary of the Tender Board Sugar Board of Tanzania (SBT), 6th Floor, Sukari House, Sokoine Drive/Ohio Street, P.O.Box 4355, Dar es Salaam**, from 08.00 am to 16.30 pm on working days (Mondays to Fridays). Saturdays, Sundays and Public holidays are excluded.
 5. A complete set of Tendering Document(s) **in English** and additional sets may be obtained by interested Tenderers at the office of the Secretary of the Tender Board Sugar Board of Tanzania (SBT), 6th Floor, Sukari House, Sokoine Drive/Ohio Street, P.O.Box 4355, Dar es Salaam.
 6. All bids must be accompanied by a tender securing declaration in the format provided in the bidding documents.
 7. All Tenders in one original plus **two** copies properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes must be delivered to address below at or before 10:00 am local time on Tenders will be opened promptly thereafter in public and in the presence of Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend in the opening at the Board Hall.
 8. Late Tenders portion of Tenders, electronic Tenders, and Tenders not received, Tenders not opened at the Tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstances.
